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USA Format

Abbreviations

ch.	Chain
sc.	Single Crochet
dc.	Double Crochet
rpt.	Repeat
tch.	Turning Chain
DNT.	Do Not Turn

Group. (2dc, ch2, 1sc)
in same space or stitch.

Base of ch. Work in first stitch.

Size approx: 10 x 10 inches

Materials

For great results it is always best to use the recommended yarn
I have used approximately:-

50 grams of King Cole Cottonsoft DK

An equivalent yarn would be a light worsted #3 cotton

Crochet Hook Sizes

4.00mm & 3.50mm

GAUGE - 5dc & 3.5 rows measures approx 1 inch

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Using 4.00mm hook ch40 loosely, work 1dc in 4th ch from hook, \* skip 2ch, (2dc, ch2, 1sc) in next ch, \* rpt from \* to \* last 3ch, skip 2ch, 2dc in last ch. Turn. (11 groups)

### **Pattern Row -**

ch3, 1dc in base of ch3, (2dc, ch2, 1sc) in next ch2 space, \* skip 2dc and sc, (2dc, ch2, 1sc) in next ch2 space, \* rpt from \* to \* to end, skip 2dc, work 2dc in top of ch3. Turn.



Rpt **Pattern Row** until 22 rows have been worked in all from beginning.  
Turn.

Change to 3.50mm hook.

### **Border** -

ch1, 1sc in base of ch1, 1sc in next dc, \* work 1sc in next ch2 space, 1sc in each of next 2dc, \* rpt from \* to \* to last dc and 3tch, 1sc in dc, 3sc in top of ch3, work 32sc evenly in row ends down first side of cloth, 3sc in corner, 1sc in each ch along starting chain edge, 3sc in corner, work 32sc evenly in row ends up second side of cloth, 1sc in corner, sl st to first sc on beginning of row. Turn.

Starting with ch1, 1sc in base of ch1, work 1 row of 1sc in each sc around cloth to end, working 3sc in corners, sl st to first sc on beginning of row.  
Turn.

### **Patterned Edge** -

ch3, (2dc, ch2, 1sc) in base of ch3, \* skip 2sc, (2dc, ch2, 1sc) in next sc, \* rpt from \* to \* around cloth to end, working (3dc, ch2, 1sc) in corners, sl st to top of ch3 on beginning of row. **DNT**.

**Loop** - sl st to next ch2 space, ch20, sl st to sl st. Fasten off.

**Finishing** - Weave in and trim off any loose ends of yarn.

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# Hanging Dishcloth

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## UK Format

### Abbreviations

|      |                |
|------|----------------|
| ch.  | Chain          |
| dc.  | Double Crochet |
| tr.  | Treble Crochet |
| rpt. | Repeat         |
| tch. | Turning Chain  |
| DNT. | Do Not Turn    |

**Group.** (2tr, 2ch, 1dc)  
into same space or stitch.

**Base of ch.** Work into first stitch

**Size approx:** 10 x 10 inches



### Materials

For great results it is always best to use the recommended yarn  
I have used approximately:-

50 grams of King Cole Cottonsoft DK

### **Crochet Hook Sizes**

4.00mm

3.50mm

**TENSION** - 5tr & 3.5 rows measures approx 1 inch



Using 4.00mm hook make 40ch loosely, work 1tr into 4th ch from hook, \* miss 2ch, (2tr, 2ch, 1dc) into next ch, \* rpt from \* to \* last 3ch, miss 2ch, 2tr into last ch. Turn. (11 groups)

### **Pattern Row -**

3ch, 1tr into base of 3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 1dc) into next 2ch space, \* miss 2tr and dc, (2tr, 2ch, 1dc) into next 2ch space, \* rpt from \* to \* to end, miss 2tr, work 2tr into top of 3ch. Turn.

Rpt **Pattern Row** until 22 rows have been worked in all from beginning.  
Turn.

Change to 3.50mm hook.

### **Border** -

1ch, 1dc into base of 1ch, 1dc into next tr, \* work 1dc into next 2ch space, 1dc into each of next 2tr, \* rpt from \* to \* to last tr and 3tr, 1dc into tr, 3dc into top of 3ch, work 32dc evenly into row ends down first side of cloth, 3dc into corner, 1dc into each ch along starting chain edge, 3dc into corner, work 32dc evenly into row ends up second side of cloth, 1dc into corner, ss to first dc on beginning of row. Turn.

Starting with 1ch, 1dc into base of 1ch, work 1 row of 1dc into each dc around cloth to end, working 3dc into corners, ss to first dc on beginning of row. Turn.

### **Patterned Edge** -

3ch, (2tr, 2ch, 1dc) into base of 3ch, \* miss 2dc, (2tr, 2ch, 1dc) into next dc, \* rpt from \* to \* around cloth to end, working (3tr, 2ch, 1dc) into corners, ss to top of 3ch on beginning of row. **DNT**.

**Loop** - ss to next 2ch space, make 20ch, ss to ss. Fasten off.

**Finishing** - Weave in and trim off any loose ends of yarn.

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
